CHIEF JUDGE ORDER 2021-17

PR BOND AUTHORITY, RELEASE, AND STANDARD CONDITIONS

Pursuant to C.R.S. § 16-4-106, it is hereby ordered that defendants who are granted PR bonds shall be released from custody on the day the PR bond is granted, unless ordered otherwise by the court.

The El Paso County Justice Services Department, Pretrial Services Program shall monitor compliance for conditions ordered by the Court on PR Bonds. Commissioners may monitor compliance by means of weekly or random breathalyzer, buccal swabs, or urinalysis. The PR Bond Commissioners may recommend revocation to the Court when compliance monitoring test results do not comply with court-ordered conditions.

Standard conditions of all PR Bonds are as follows:

- Shall not leave the state without Judge's permission
- No driving without a valid driver's license
- No illegal drug use
- Shall appear as ordered for all court proceedings
- No violations of criminal law

If DUI Charge, standard conditions of PR Bond are as follows:

- Random sobriety monitoring, as ordered by the court
- No alcohol or illegal drug consumption

If DV Charge, standard conditions of PR Bond are as follows:

- Comply with any active protection orders—criminal or civil
- No possession of weapons, firearms, or ammunition
- File with the court the Firearms Relinquishment Affidavit within seven days of the issuance of the protection order and a use of force finding by the court

This order rescinds Chief Judge Order 2007-4 and Chief Judge Order 17-02.
